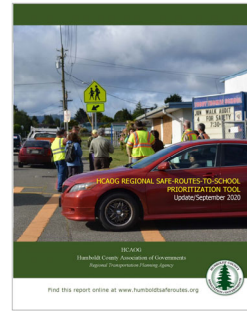

It's International WALK AND BIKE TO SCHOOL DAY

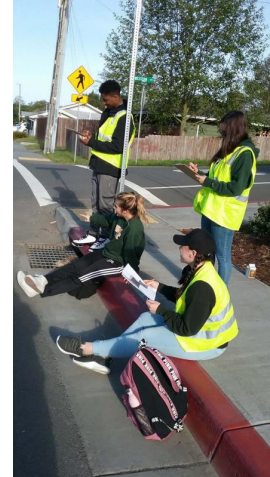
Wednesday October 10th

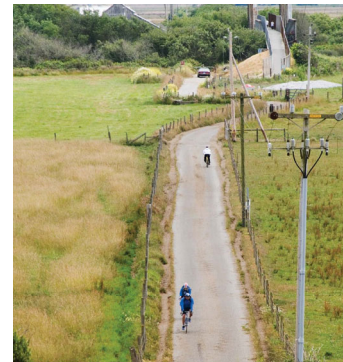
