






## Going for 10%

#### **Travel Trends...**

- 19% of <u>all</u> trips
- 39% of roadway deaths
- 1% of current transportation funding

Disparities concentrate impacts in low-income communities of color

#### ...didn't match the \$\$\$

- 70% of revenue is local
- Props A & C, Measure R= 0% for walk/bike
- \$20 billion unfunded need



## Statewide Funding

- The <u>Active Transportation</u> <u>Program</u> (ATP) is the only significant source of funds dedicated to increasing bicycling and walking in California.
- It represents approximately one percent of the state's annual transportation budget.
- ATP funds bike and pedestrian infrastructure projects, educational and promotional efforts, safe routes to school projects, and active transportation planning.




