Outride: Outride is a non-profit organization dedicated to improving the lives of youth through cycling. **RIDING FOR FOCUS (R4F)** is their middle school-based PE program. R4F promotes cycling as an outlet for students to improve their cognitive, physical, and socio-emotional well-being. Schools can acquire R4F via two pathways - by purchasing the program, or for schools serving under-resourced communities, by applying for a program grant. Schools are provided with everything they need to get their 6th-8th grade students riding, including bikes, helmets, curriculum, and intensive teacher training. Find out more here:
