



Systems Change Levers/ 6 E's	Objective Example
Shift Power (equity, engagement, and evaluation)	 Conduct walk audit with staff, families, and community members Gather feedback on demonstration project through a survey and tabling event
Reset Culture (education and encouragement)	 Conduct school travel tally Organize walking school busses Host a bike rodeo Implement a Safe Routes to School pledge program
Transform Land Use (engineering)	 Implement a quick build project (using walk audit findings) and explore making it permanent Test out a <i>school street</i> in front of the school and explore making it permanent
